

## Aims for Fiscal Year 2020

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Serving as a library within a Model School for Global Science and Engineering Education

1. Strengthening of library functions as a support organization for study and research

(1) Conducting surveys and analyzing data to improve usage

- Strengthen human support and guidance, and introduce how to use materials and information
- Analyze questionnaires and take action to improve them. Conduct web-based 'library satisfaction surveys' and questionnaires. Analyze the needs of users, including teachers and international students, and expand the collection of materials.
- In preparation for the completion of the Faculty of Architecture, we aim to increase the number of materials for graduates and the collection to 20,000 foreign books.
- (2) Transmission of library information (expansion of publicity, visualization of library work)
  - Publication of the second edition of the library's annual report and posting on the website to make our activities more visible.
- 2. Activities to promote the use of e-journals to support research activities
  - Collaboration with relevant departments to publicize the effectiveness of ejournals
  - Create an accessible environment and strengthen the promotion of the use of e-resources
- 3. Promotion of library utilization for job-hunting activities
  - Updating and collecting the most up-to-date and accurate materials, as well as strengthening cooperation within the university to promote the use of job-hunting materials.
  - Organize information sessions on job hunting-related databases, with the aim of increasing their use by lower year of students.
