

Objectives for the 100th Anniversary

- ①Corporate brand enhancement:

 Integrated in FY2022, the library is working on reorganizing its functions with the aim of fulfilling its role as a new center for academic information.
- ②Corporate brand enhancement 【Composition and utilization of materials corresponding to the course system, graduate school application, and post-corona】:

 Composition of materials (including e-books) to meet the needs of the course system and the enhancement of the graduate school system.
- (3) [50% employment in 400 major companies]:

 Continue to collect and disseminate the latest information on job-hunting related materials, and utilize the library as a place to support job-hunting opportunities.
- 4 [30% of female student ratio]:
 Analyze and collect information on library usage by female students and reflect it in library management.
- (5) 【Continuation of SGU Globalization Promotion】:

 Enhance materials for international students (including electronic materials) and create

 English-language guidance materials (e.g., videos) for international students and promote
 their use.

<Departmental goals for the first year (FY2023) >

- ① Analyze data on material composition and usage to organize materials accordingly, improve the environment of the expansion area, publish the library's annual report and PR magazine (in Japanese and English) to increase visibility of the library's activity, and hold an exhibition of Ekiden-related materials.
- ② Continue to provide information in conjunction with career support section's events, offer the library as a venue for online interviews, and post job-hunting related information in the library, including employment results from 400 major companies.
- ③ Implement exhibitions for female students, collect and reflect opinions of female students on library projects (exhibitions, events, etc.), and conduct gender-based surveys in the library satisfaction survey to reflect their requests.
- ④ Conduct a satisfaction survey for international students, increase the number of overseas materials (including electronic materials) and language materials, and improve support functions for writing papers in English.

< This year's challenges in the department >

- Creation and implementation of a plan for reorganizing the distribution of library materials (especially in Toyosu Library) (first step is to organize duplicated materials).
- SDGs: In cooperation with student groups, continuously disseminate information on the SDGs through exhibitions and other means, and collect related materials.
