
- 1) Coordination with career support section
 - We encourage students to borrow (use) job-hunting related materials, including e-books via distribution of leaflets at job-hunting courses and seminars (including online seminars). 45 sessions were held in FY2024.



- Securities Report Database EOL Guidance was held on December 11th (Toyosu) and on December 19th (Omiya) in conjunction with the Career Support Section (total of 89 students participated, including those who joined online). A video of the guidance was available on the library website for campus use only. Participant feedback included comments such as:
- ❖ "It was extremely helpful to learn in detail how to read securities reports and how to use them for job hunting."
- ♦ "I began job searching without even knowing how to read the company profiles in the Shikiho. This session allowed me to understand the things we don't usually learn like companies' financial status and management policies, and it was very meaningful."





- · "List of 400 well-known companies and the employment results of our graduates" was prepared and posted in the library during the open campus.








