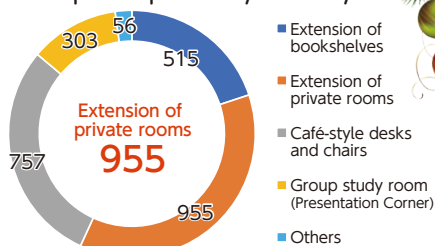

We aim to provide better library services.

We conducted a library usage satisfaction survey from September 21 to October 15, 2021. In this special issue, we would like to report the results of the survey and the efforts of each library in response to the feedback. We received 1,752 responses across departments, not only from within the library, but also from Scomb and the Web page.

Facilities and equipment that should be enhanced with the expansion plan of Toyosu Library:

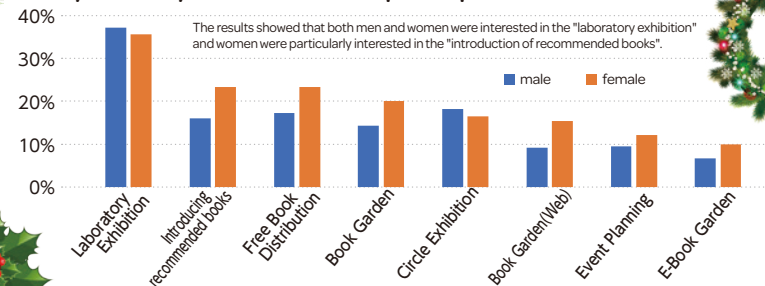


- As the number of online classes increases, there are many requests to set up conversational booths.

The most common request was for "more private rooms," followed by "café-style desks and chairs."

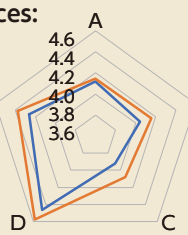
Library events you would like to participate in:



The results showed that both men and women were interested in the "laboratory exhibition" and women were particularly interested in the "introduction of recommended books".

The overall rating expect the library website was 4.19, up 1.2 points from last year. By gender, women gave a higher rating than men in all categories. In particular, female international students gave an overall rating of 4.27.
