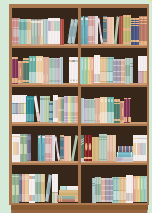


01. Special Features **Toyosu Library has been renewed!**

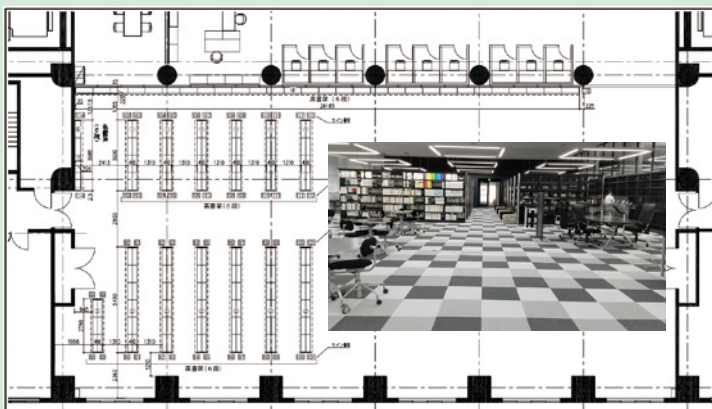

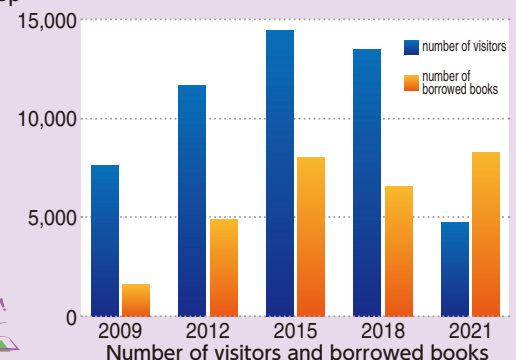

If you are interested in any books, please come to the library at your earliest convenience since we offer them first-come, first-served basis.

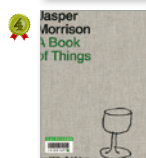
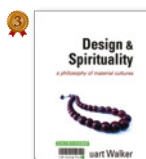
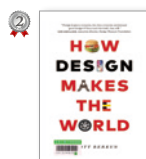
